

HARMONIC SEQUENCE

HARMONIC SEQUENCE occurs when a harmonic progression is repeated on a different note.

The Circle of Fifths is often used to create a harmonic sequence, with the pairs of chords forming a V-I relationship. (See p. 182.)




In the following example, beginning with the second chord, the chords have a V-I relationship.




C Major e minor a minor d minor G Major C Major
